



## Non-Filer PLUS Loan Statement

Although the federal government does not require that a Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA) be filed to qualify for a Parent Loan for Undergraduate Students (PLUS), this statement must be completed prior to PLUS loan certification.
