



PLUS Loan Request

There are ways to make your investment in a Doane education affordable.

The **Federal Parent Loan for Undergraduate Students (PLUS Loan)** is one way for credit-worthy parents to borrow for their child’s college educational costs. It’s a fixed interest rate loan of 8.5% with at least two disbursements - one for each semester in the academic year. Interest accrual begins when the loan is first disbursed, and repayment begins within 60 days after you receive the final disbursement, typically spring semester. A brochure is included for your review.

Parents can borrow the cost of education minus the amount of financial aid the student receives. We encourage you to complete the FAFSA (Free Application for Federal Student Aid) before you apply for the PLUS loan to make sure your student explores the best financial aid available.

Note: the last day to process a federal PLUS loan for the 2007-08 academic year is April 15, 2008.
