When to Apply

Applications to Doane College are accepted on a rolling basis. Notification of the admission decision will be approximately two weeks following receipt of all application materials.

- Application form (including personal statement)
- Final high school transcripts
- Official transcripts from each college and/or university attended
- Official ACT or SAT scores (if completed 23 or fewer semester hours of college coursework)
- Two letters of recommendation (professor, employer, teacher, etc)
- No application fee!
